

Garbage Disposals Not Recommended

Due to Septic Tanks/Fields

Your home has a septic tank and field installed to process waste generated in the house, as opposed to a public sewer. Your system has been sized according to the number of bathrooms and fixtures that exist in the home. You will be responsible for the maintenance and occasional pumping of the septic tank.

The waste in the tank and field is broken down and processed by anaerobic activity and bacteria. A garbage disposal, if added after closing, can fill the tank and field with grease, oils or other items that do not degrade in the way the system is designed. This may cause clogs and/or more frequent pumping of the tank.

Hodorowski Homes does not recommend adding a garbage disposal to the waste management system of your home. If one is added after closing, it will void the warranty on the septic system.
